This holiday schedule is as published by the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston. Vermont's banking law permits state-chartered banks to remain open or close any or all their banking offices on any of these days. Vermont chartered banks must post their days and hours of operation at or near public entrance (see 8 V.S.A., sections 11202 – 11205).

*For holidays falling on a **Saturday**, the Federal Reserve Banks and Branches will be open the preceding Friday; however, the Board of Governors will be closed.

For holidays falling on a **Sunday, all Federal Reserve offices will be closed the following Monday.
